From the Desk of the Principal – 2016 Term 2 Mdm Aini Maarof

Dear Parents,

Term 2 has been exciting term filled with many activities that showcased our students' talents as well as their values in action.

During the second week of the term, three Awards Presentations were held to celebrate and honour the efforts of our students, as well as the dedication and hard work of our staff and the unwavering support and partnership of the Unity Community. A total of 258 students, 17 staff and 9 partners were awarded this year.

The Unity learning experience is more than mere academic pursuits. It is a rhapsody of experiences that allows our students to explore a world of possibilities. Aesthetics Education is one such learning experience. It instils a sense of creativity and imagination in them. More than a third of our students had the opportunity of a 'delicious' experience in performing for our biennial musical, Rhapsody IV 'Makan Rhapsody – Good Friends, Great Food, Glorious Times!'. This year, Rhapsody IV also showcased the artistic talents of our teachers and former students. The show was a success drawing great applause and compliments from the audience.

For CCAs, our Boys Brigade clinched the Gold Award in Boys' Brigade Blaze 2016. Our Athletics teams did the school proud in the 2016 National Track & Field Championship. Nor Qumairah and Tai Jia Qi qualified for 100m and 200m semi-finals. Ng Wei Hao qualified for the 400m semi-finals. Our four relay teams also qualified for the 4 X 100m semi-finals. Two of our students, August Lim and Foo Mao Kang qualified for the finals in the 3000m and 2000m Steeplechase and 800m events respectively. In the National Inter-school Cross Country Championship 2016, our B Division Boys (August Lim, Foo Mao Kang, Marcus Lim, Shanwin Henry, Muhammad Zaifan, Lyuk Takeda Shin) were placed in the top 10 while our B Division Girls (Janani Elvarasan, Ada Wong, Nur Syafiqah, Ong Yi Lin, Christine Mak, Tai Jia Qi) were placed 15th.

As part of the character and leadership development of our students, Leadership Learning Week (24-26 May 2016), which holds a series of leadership learning activities, has been planned for all Sec 1-3 students to enhance their learning experiences. Schedule for the Leadership Learning Week was issued with letters to all parents/guardians dated 29 April 2016.

Our Sec 4 Express and Sec 5 Normal Academic students will be sitting for the O-Level MTL Written Examination on 30 May 2016. The MTL Intensive Programme was planned for these students from 20-26 May 2016. I would like to take this opportunity to wish these students all the best.

On the academic front, many students had performed well in their Mid-Year Examinations. I congratulate their effort. For those who need more time to build a strong foundation, I urge them to make good use of the June holidays to take stock of their learning and strive for improvement.

Our teachers have been relentlessly giving their best to guide and develop our students to realise their potential. On this note, I would like to invite all parents to join me in expressing our gratitude towards our teachers. 2.2.3 Singapore Mathematical Olympiad

The Singapore Mathematical Olympiad (SMO) is an established and recognised annual national Mathematics competition organised by the Singapore Mathematical Society at the National University of Singapore. This competition is specially meant for students who have an aptitude and passion for Mathematics. It aims to arouse students' interest and enthusiasm for mathematical problem solving, develop mathematical intuition, reasoning and logical thinking, as well as creative and critical thinking.

In Unity Secondary School, a group of students with good record of mathematics results have been specially selected and went through a period of rigorous training to prepare them for this competition. These students include 30 lower secondary students and 37 upper secondary students and they have been specially selected to participate in the SMO Junior and Senior sections respectively. SMO will be held on 31st May 2016, Tuesday, at the National University of Singapore (NUS).

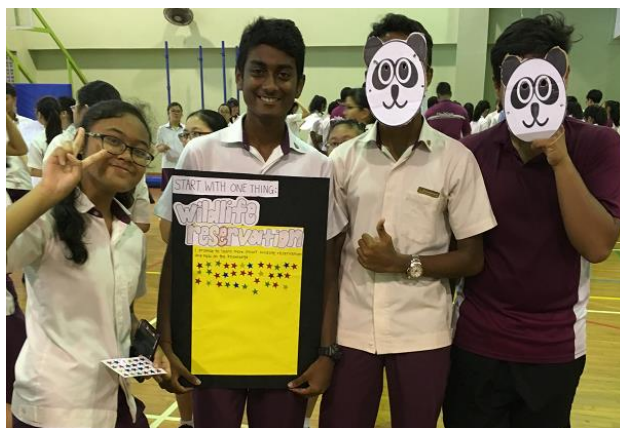
3.1 Character and Leadership Development (CLD)

3.1.1 Unity Students' Values-In-Action (VIA) Programme

The pictures below feature some of our Sec 4 & 5 students at their "Global Issues in ASEAN Countries" Symposium as part of commemorating International Friendship Day.



At the end of each VIA programme, students will reflect on their learning in their individual reflection logs on how they have led themselves and served others through the programmes. This helps them to internalise the values they have learnt.

On top of the VIA programmes listed above, students also organise Student-Initiated VIA activities to put their values and leadership skills into action. The Sec 2 students will be involved in organising a Fun Fair to raise funds for the Children's Charities Association as part of the End-Year Leadership Learning Week programmes.

3.1.2 Character and Leadership Development (CLD) Assessment

As shared in the first issue of the newsletter, our school adopts a whole-school approach to develop every student as a committed leader guided by sound values and effective life skills. This is done through the weekly Character and Leadership Education (CLE) lessons as well as the various experiential learning platforms in the areas of Values-In-Action (VIA), National Education (NE), Aesthetic Programme (AEP), Cultural Education Programme (CEP), Environment Education Programme (EEP), Education and Career Guidance (ECG) and Co-Curricular Activities (CCA).

In line with the emphasis on the Character and Leadership Development (CLD) of our students, the CLD Assessment is implemented annually to provide students with a holistic overview of their character and leadership development. It also serves to affirm, recognise and motivate students in their leadership learning.

The CLD assessment comprises two key areas: Character and Leadership Education (CLE) and Co-Curricular Activities (CCA). A set of rubrics has been developed to assess the extent to which our students demonstrate the school values, leadership competencies and citizenship in the classroom as well as through their co-curricular activities. There are three levels of assessment: Teacher-Assessment (2 Form Teachers (FTs) and 1 CCA teacher), Self-Assessment (the student himself / herself) and Peer-Assessment (an assigned peer who knows the student).

The CLD assessment will be conducted in Term 3 and the results will be consolidated and captured in the CLD Report, which will be issued together with the Progress Report in Term 3 Week 10 by the FTs. This CLD Report is to be kept in students' report books as a point of reference for their holistic development reporting.

We believe that assessment is an integral part of the holistic development of students and it will motivate them to demonstrate positive values, leadership competencies and citizenship in their day-to-day activities. We look forward to your partnership in nurturing our students to be committed leaders guided by sound values and effective life skills.

Strategic Thrust 4: High Care, High Discipline, High Pride

Through high level of care from the school, our students exude strong discipline and pride

4.1 Uniform and Bearing Check

Our strategic Thrust 4, High Care, High Discipline, High Pride, guides us in ensuring student well-being through a high level of care and discipline in the school, so that all students will be able to carry themselves with a high level of self-discipline and personal pride.

The school emphasises on the need to take care of one's personal bearing which is an important aspect of instilling self-discipline and personal pride. The school believes in working closely with parents to monitor the students' personal bearing and grooming. There is a scheduled Uniform and Bearing Check in Term 3 Week 1 (**Tuesday, 28 June**). Please ensure that your child is ready for the check.

4.2 Holistic Health Education

What is mental health or emotional health?

Mental or emotional health refers to your overall psychological well-being. It includes the way you feel about yourself, the quality of your relationships, and your ability to manage your feelings and deal with difficulties.

Good mental health is not just the absence of mental health problems. Being mentally or emotionally healthy is much more than being free of depression, anxiety, or other psychological issues. Rather than the absence of mental illness, mental and emotional health refers to the presence of positive characteristics. Similarly, not feeling bad is not the same as feeling good. While some people may not have negative feelings, they still need to do things that make them feel positive in order to achieve mental and emotional health.

Tips for Improving Mental Health

1. Get enough rest

To have good mental and emotional health, it's important to take care of your body. That includes getting enough sleep. Most people need seven to eight hours of sleep each night in order to function optimally.

2. Give your mind what it needs to function properly

Nutrition can play in an important role in how you feel. If you are deficient in key nutrients such as folic acid, omega 3, zinc and B vitamins, your overall mood and energy levels are very likely to suffer. There are also many substances that can have a negative impact on your mental health, such as nicotine, caffeine, alcohol and other recreational substances. To improve your mental health you need to make sure you provide your brain with the nutrients it needs in order to function properly. Sunlight lifts your mood, so try to get at least 10 to 15 minutes of sun per day. This can be done while exercising, gardening, or socializing.

3. Strengthen your body and your mind will follow

Exercise plays an effective role in improving mental health. Exercise such as running or going to the gym releases chemicals in your brain that make you feel good, and studies have shown that exercise can be as effective as medication in mild to moderate depression.

4. Make leisure time a priority.

Do things for no other reason than that it feels good to do them. Go to a funny movie, take a walk on the beach, listen to music, read a good book, or talk to a friend. Doing things just because they are fun is no indulgence. Play is an emotional and mental health necessity.

- Reduce outdoor activities during the hot part of the day or stay in the shade
- Plan your sport and exercise activity in the cooler hours of the day
- Watch for symptoms of heat-induced illness and seek medical attention

Protection Against Excessive Exposure to Ultraviolet (UV) Radiation

- Some UV exposure is important for health functions such as Vitamin D production in the body and treating diseases like jaundice in babies.
- Excessive exposure to solar UV radiation can result in harmful effects to the skin and eyes. If you must be out in the sun, especially between 11am and 3pm when the UV index levels are highest, the following simple protective measures can help to minimise the effects:
 - Use sunscreen (at least SPF 30)
 - Use umbrella and seek shade
 - Wear sunglasses that block UV rays
 - Wear broad-brimmed hat

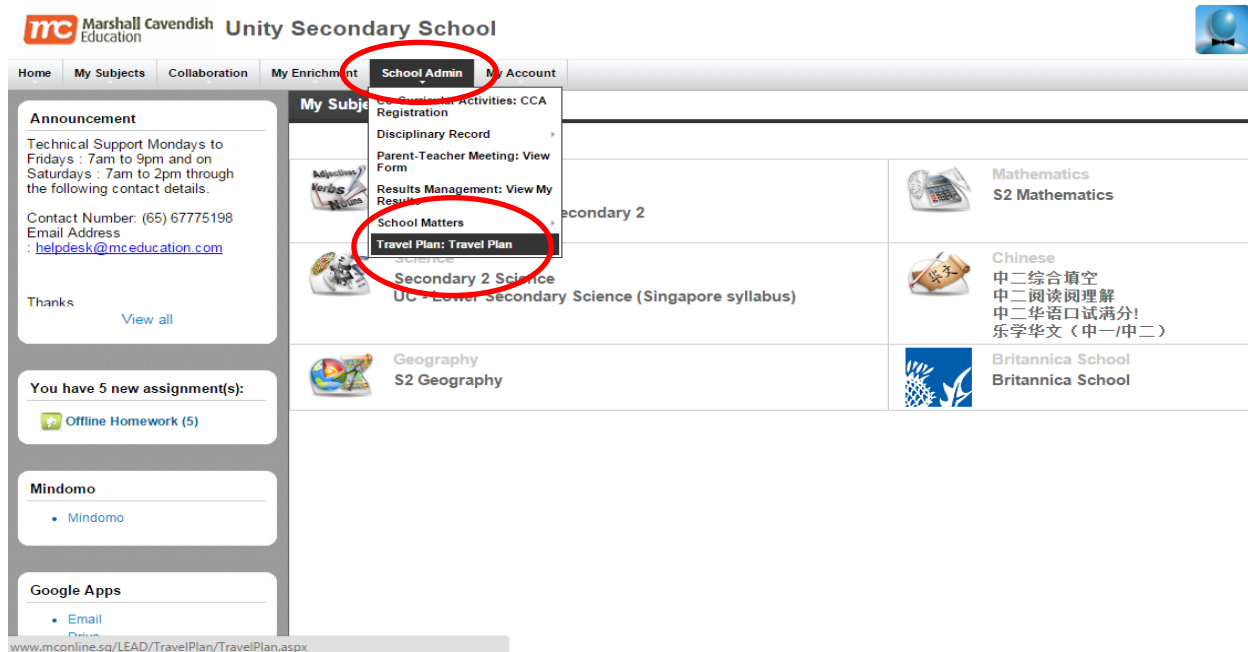

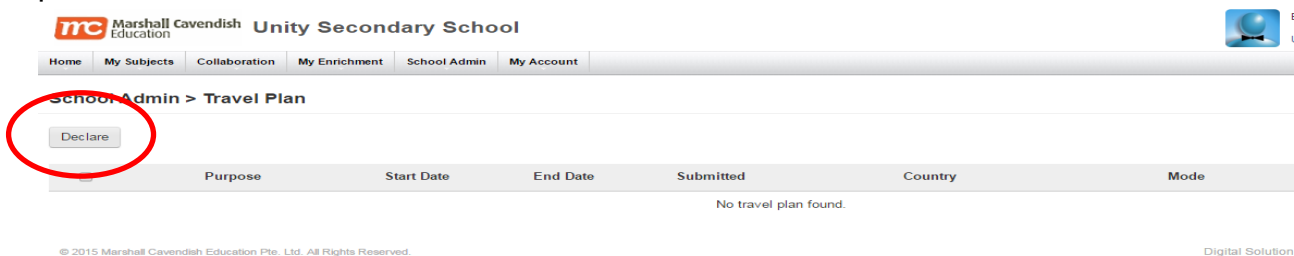
