From the Desk of the Principal – 2016 Term 1 Mdm Aini Maarof

Dear Parents,

Term 1 has been a vibrant start of the school year with our students and teachers engaged in many meaningful learning activities.

I am happy to see our Sec 1 Unitians settling in well into secondary school life and embracing a new phase of holistic development in their growing-up years.

I am pleased to share the good performance of our students in the GCE N and O Level Exams. Our 2015 cohort of N-Level has achieved strong results. Our students have achieved above national percentage passes in 11 out of 12 subjects, with 8 subjects scoring percentage distinctions above national. 85.4% of our students (compared to national percentage of 74.9%) qualified for Sec 5NA, out of which many qualified for Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) and Direct Entry to Polytechnic Programme (DPP).

The 2015 O-Level cohort has also delivered commendable performances. Overall, more than 95% of our 4E/5N students are eligible for an A-Level or a Polytechnic Diploma course. I am proud of our Unitians putting into action the school values of Commitment and Perseverance to actualize their potential and aspirations in their academic pursuit. Supporting the students is our team of dedicated teachers. I would like to honour our teachers for their care and efforts in ensuring effective teaching and learning.

Our Unitians have also done well in the CCAs. In the Overall Unit Proficiency Awards for Uniformed Groups, our NCC (Air), Girls' Brigade and Scouts units have clinched Gold Awards and our NPCC Unit achieved the Silver Award. Our 'B' Division Basketball (Girls) team came in 2nd runner up at the West Zone Basketball Championship thus qualifying the team to the Nationals rounds starting in Term 2. Students in Unique Productions CCA (our in-house media production CCA) had also participated in the Anti-Drug Video Competition organised by Central Narcotics Bureau, and emerged 2nd place in this nationwide competition.

In terms of Leadership Learning, our new batch of Class Councillors and Unity Councillors has been formally appointed in Term 1, marking the milestone of their journey of development to be a leader of teams and leader of leaders. I would like to record our appreciation to the 5th Unity Council for the quality leadership provided to the Unity Community and for the hard work in serving the Unity Community.

I also applaud the good work of many Unitians in supporting the CCA Open House, the commemoration of Total Defence Day, the celebration of Chinese New Year, the opening of National School Games, the delivering of the Cyberwellness programme and the annual Unity Run. I am certainly proud to see our Unitians leading themselves in serving others, actualizing themselves in inspiring others.

I look forward to more school motto and school values in action by Unitians in Term 2. Wishing all a restful March holiday break.

2.1 Mid-Year Examination (MYE) Time-tables

2.3 Social Scientist & Entrepreneurship Programme (SSEP)

The Social Scientist and Entrepreneurship Programme (SSEP) is a 2-year programme offered by the Humanities Department to develop students with an aptitude and passion for the Social Sciences. Students in SSEP can choose from a selection of modules, based on the domains of Social Studies, Geography and History. These modules aim to provide opportunities for the students to hone their research, presentation and critical thinking skills while exposing them to a broad range of issues in the Humanities. Modules can also include field trips and national competitions as part of the students' learning.

Last year, SSEP students participated in a variety of competitions including the National Pushcart Challenge and the Marketing Innovation Challenge organised by Republic Polytechnic, National Stamp Collecting Competition by Singapore Philatelic Museum and Inter-school History War and Diplomacy Challenge by Bendemeer Secondary School. This year, our students will also be offered the opportunity to participate in the Tourism-in-Action Competition by Ngee Ann Polytechnic and the 9th International Model United Nations Conference by Anglo-Chinese School (Independent).

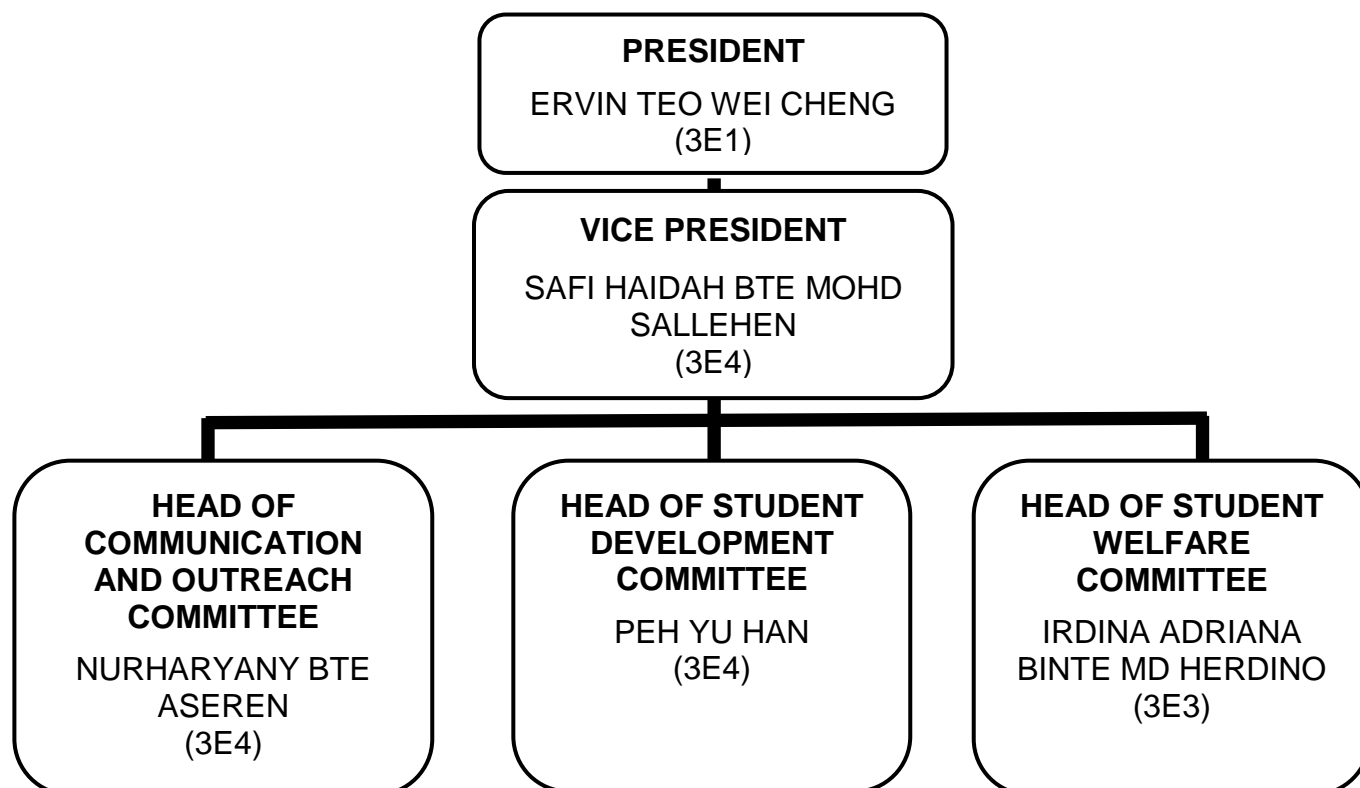

4.2 Discipline

Our Strategic Thrust 4, High Care, High Discipline, High Pride, guides us in ensuring student well-being through high level of care and discipline in the school, so that all students carry themselves with high level of self-discipline and personal pride. In this regard, the school emphasises much on decorum which is an important indicator of students' self-discipline and personal pride.

We believe in working closely with parents to monitor the students' decorum. The Discipline Committee has issued a Notification Letter to all parents to keep parents informed of the Schedule of Decorum Checks in Term 1. The Discipline Committee has scheduled two Decorum Checks in Term 2 (**Tuesday, 22 March and Tuesday, 5 April**). Reminders will be given to students one week before the official checks. Parents will also be notified via SMS before the checks.

4.3 Holistic Health Education

Healthy Tip For Healthy Living: The Importance of Breakfast

Breakfast is the most important meal of the day. Studies had shown that jump starting the day with a healthy breakfast benefits people of all ages – children, adults and the elderly. Below are the reasons why.

- Breakfast is the first chance the body has to refuel its blood glucose after eight to 12 hours without a meal or snack.
- Glucose is essential for the brain and is the main energy source. It helps curb your hunger and prevent binge eating later in the day by breaking fast after 8 to 12 hours without food.
- It provides an alternative source for daily intake requirement for fiber if you like to consume bread and cereals for breakfast.
- A nice healthy breakfast marks a good start for the rest of the day!

Breakfast should always include protein and plenty of fiber, which will help satisfy your hunger and keep you feeling full till lunch time. Cereals, muesli, oats, buns, breads with peanut butter spread, eggs and fruits coupled with low fat milk, yoghurt, juices or smoothies are great and healthy choices for breakfast.

Try to avoid food with high sugar levels, sodium, saturated fats and calories like nasi lemak, laksa, rice and fried noodles. You can occasionally reward yourself with pancakes, waffles and muffins so as to have some varieties to your breakfast. If you really don't like to eat breakfast, you can split it up into two smaller meals. Eat a hard-boiled egg at home, and an hour or two later, take a break from work and snack on an apple and a handful of healthy nuts like pecans or walnuts.

Always remember, healthy living leads to better quality of life. Enjoy your breakfast!

5.1 Updating of parents' contact details and commuting status

As it is important for the school to have the updated contact details of all parents, it would be appreciated if parents could inform the school of any changes to their contact details promptly.

Also, if your child is commuting to school daily or weekly (eg; coming to school from Johor), please update the school promptly as this information is critical as part of our emergency preparedness.

5.2 Electronic Meal Coupon System

Currently, the school provides meal subsidies to students under the Financial Assistance Scheme using paper coupons. Moving forward, as part of the school's continuous improvement, meal subsidies provided to students will be done electronically. This will be effective from Term 2 (21 March 2016). With the implementation of electronic meal subsidy, students can purchase food and drinks at the school canteen using their existing Student Smart Card (SSC).

To start the process, students eligible for the meal subsidies are requested to come to the General Office to register their SSC before 18 March 2016.

5.3 Safety Updates

5.3.1 Medical Status Updates

Please update the school promptly when there is a change in the medical status of your child. This information is critical so as to ensure that extra care and support can be rendered to your child when needed.

Also, if your child is suffering from any medical conditions, do remind your child to have their medication with them at all times, for example, inhalers if they are asthmatic.

5.3.2 Fight Against Dengue

DENGUE PREVENTION

How is dengue transmitted?

- A female Aedes mosquito becomes infective after biting and sucking blood from infected person who carries the virus in the blood
- The virus is passed to healthy people when the infective Aedes mosquito bites them. This healthy people become the infected person
- The person recovered and becomes immune to serotype* infected
- However, the person can still be infected with the other 3 serotypes

*There are 4 serotypes of dengue viruses in Singapore (DENV1, DENV2, DENV3, DENV4). Dengue virus serotype (DENV2) has been the predominant serotype since 2007.

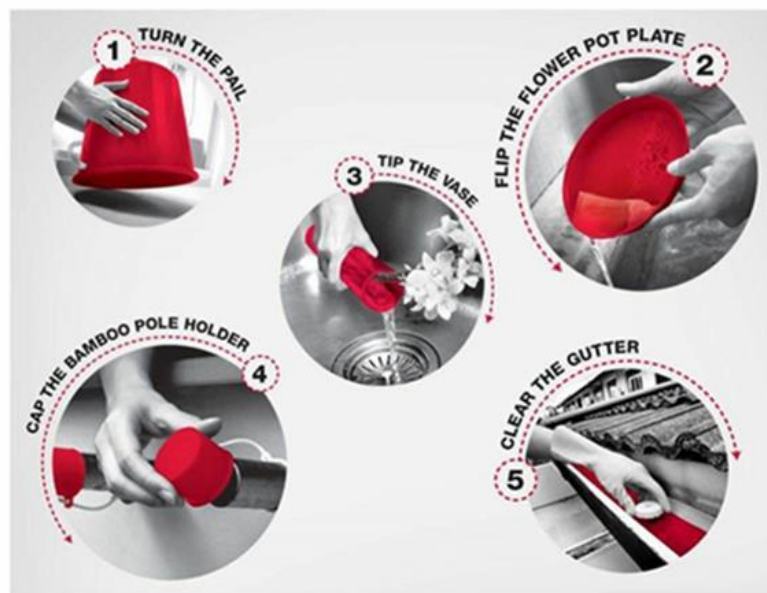
What are the symptoms of dengue?

- High Fever
- Severe Headache
- Muscle and Joint Pains
- Rashes
- Nausea and Vomiting

How can you protect yourself?

- Use insect repellent. It helps to repel mosquitoes and reduces the chance of being bitten but it does not mosquito-proof a person. It just offers added protection
- Change water in vases/bowls on alternate days
- Turn over all water storage containers
- Remove water from flower pot plates on alternate days
- Cover bamboo pole holders when not in use
- Clear blockages and put Bti insecticide in roof gutters monthly
