CCA GRADING SCHEME

- In Secondary school, CCA is compulsory.
- At the end of 4 or 5 years in Unity, students will attain one of these CCA attainment levels
 - Excellent – 2 bonus points
 - Good – 1 bonus point
 - Fair – 0 bonus point

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION ADMISSION



- Junior Colleges / Polytechnics / Institute of Technical Education
 - For Direct School Admission (DSA-JC) or Early Admission Exercise (Polytechnic)
 - Bonus points awarded can be used to offset raw aggregate score for the different post secondary institutions

CCA GRADING SCHEME

- LEAPS 2.0 – Attainment Levels
- To achieve 2 bonus points, you need to achieve a minimum level 3 in each domain and a level 4 in at least one of the domains
- Leadership
- Achievement
- Participation
- Service



KEY FACTOR (LEAPS 2.0)

Leadership- leadership position in your CCA

- Works towards holding a leadership position (min. Senior executive member) to achieve level 3
- Every Sec 3 Unitian a CCA leader



KEY FACTOR (LEAPS 2.0)

Achievement- Representing the school for external school competitions

- Works towards representing the schools for 2 years for level 3 achievement.
- This is one of the reasons why we need to set quota for sports CCAs. (The NSGs only allow a certain number of players in each division)



KEY FACTOR (LEAPS 2.0)

Participation- Attendance in CCA

- Attendance rate must be at least **75%** for the year so the student will be able to progress to the next attainment level under the Participation Domain.
- Absence from CCA **must** be covered by Medical Certificate or Parents' Letter



Participation

- CCA Attendance will be used as a quantitative component to assess the student final conduct rating
 - This provides the child and the parents to have a more holistic feedback regarding the child behaviour and discipline in the school
- Absence without valid reason in CCA will be dealt as discipline cases

Step	Instruction	Timeline
1	Go to CCA selection portal: https://tinyurl.com/unityCCA26  Or use	From now until 11 January 2026 (Sunday) 2359hrs Log in using MIMS username and password
2	Input student's details and select the CCAs accordingly.	
3	Allocation results will be announced and made known to your child.	By end of week 2, 11 January 2026
4	Sec 1 students will start their CCA officially.	Term 1 Week 2, 16 January 2026
5	Sec 1 students can appeal to change their allocated CCA and they will be handled on a <u>case-by-case</u> basis. Appeal forms will be made available in the General Office once the CCA allocation is out.	By end of week 3

- ✓ CCA selection shortlist and vacancies

 - ✓ CCA selection shortlist and vacancies



SEC 1 CCA ALLOCATION RESULTS

- Allocation Results will be out before Term 1 Week 2 Thursday or earlier
- Your child can appeal to change your allocated CCA. Appeal forms will be made available in the General Office once the CCA allocation is out.
