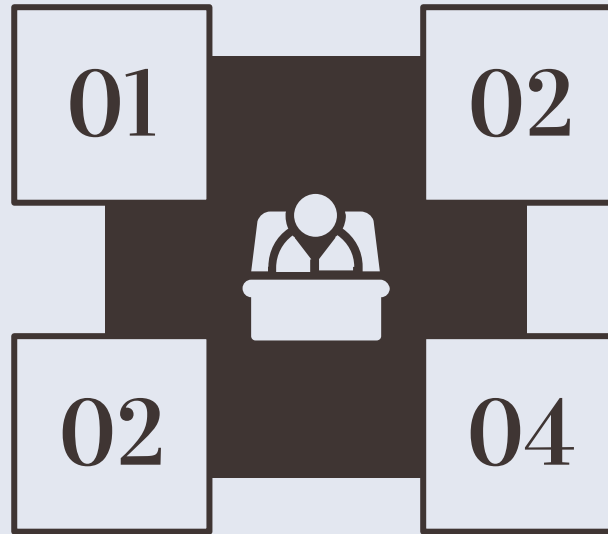


Preparation for EAE
